

You can now search family (probate) court records online in Massachusetts. This is useful for finding a) the progress of a family law case, b) the exact date of a particular court hearing or action for a case, and c) the docket number for a particular case. All you need to know is the first and last name of one of the parties.

1) Go to

2) Check the box for "I'm not a robot" and click on the "Click here" button to search public records.




3) On the "Court Department" drop down menu, select "Probate and Family Court"

4) On the "Court Division" drop-down menu, choose the county where the case took place or is taking place



5) Enter the "Last Name" and "First Name" of one of the parties. You do NOT have to enter any other information. You will get results of all family law cases from that county involving a person with the name you have entered.
